

BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Karl E. Dahlberg, CFE, CISA, CPA

Mr. Dahlberg is currently a Professor of Accounting Information Systems at Rutgers University. In this capacity, he instructs accounting information system courses at both the graduate and undergraduate level. Courses include: Introduction to Financial Accounting; Introduction to Management Accounting; Cost Accounting; and Auditing and Assurance.

Mr. Dahlberg has retired from the Federal Government. He was formally an Information Technology Specialist at the Northern New Jersey Branch Office of the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA), Picatinny, New Jersey. In that capacity, he supervised the performance of all information system reviews of Defense Contractors in Northern New Jersey. His former duties included performance of information system audits on the DCAA Region Staff, Philadelphia, Pa., and DCAA Supervisory Auditor at ITT in Clifton, New Jersey. Mr. Dahlberg has been in DCAA for 23 years.

Mr. Dahlberg is a Certified Public Accountant in the State of New Jersey, a Certified Fraud Examiner, and a Certified Information Systems Auditor. He has assisted the U. S. Attorney's Office with the use of computers and fraud allegations. He previously served as an Adjunct Professor of Accounting at Kean University, Union, New Jersey. Mr. Dahlberg has instructed the graduate course "Audit and Accounting Information Systems" at Rutgers GSM, Newark, NJ. Mr. Dahlberg had an article published in the AGA Journal (1992) *LINKING C/SCSC + MMAS + WIP - A Discussion of the Primary Contractor Planning/Execution Systems And Government Requirements*. The article was also published in the Aerospace & Defense Symposium Proceedings in 1993.

Mr. Dahlberg was involved with Enterprise Resource Planning, Automated Labor Entry and information system control reviews. He has been involved in Year 2000 Compliance reviews of Defense contractors and has lectured to State government auditors and professional organizations on the relationship between Year 2000 issues and internal controls and other system related issues.

Mr. Dahlberg earned his BA in Economics from Chapman University, Orange, California (1976) and his MBA in Accounting from Rutgers GSBA, Newark, New Jersey (1979). He is a Marine Corps combat veteran of Vietnam where he received the Purple Heart for gunshot wounds while serving as a rifle platoon leader.

Mr. Dahlberg is Past President of the New Jersey Chapter Information Systems Audit and Control Association and has instructed the Certified Information Systems Auditor Examination review course. Mr. Dahlberg is also the Past President of the Northern New Jersey Chapter of the Association of Government Accountants. Mr. Dahlberg has also been invited by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants to grade the CPA Exam as an exam reviewer and the specialist for information technology.
